Enrollment Requirements

- 1 Complete a General Information Form and submit to the Admission Office.
- 2 Take a tour of our facility. To schedule a tour, call 414.227.2889
- 3 Have an informational interview with an Admissions Coordinator.
- 4 Take and pass the entrance assessment.**
- 5 Submit a letter of intent describing your reasons and goals for enrolling in the program.
- 6 Submit a letter of recommendation.
- 7 Submit your high school transcripts showing completion or a copy of your General Education Diploma (GED).
- 8 Submit a \$50 registration fee at the time of application.
- 9 All massage students are required to receive a professional massage and submit the receipt.

Transfer Students

Applicants for transfer into cosmetology and esthiology are considered on an individual basis. The Institute of Beauty and Wellness may, at its discretion, refuse transfers if admission requirements, including tuition, cannot be met. The Institute may accept transfer hours at its discretion.

The Institute does not recruit students that are currently attending or admitted to another school offering a similar program of study.
